INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLICANTS TO GRADES 6-12
For admission in 2012-2013

Please submit your completed application and a non-refundable fee of one hundred twenty five dollars (\$125) by December 1.

In addition, each applicant must meet the following requirements.

Report Cards:

Parents are responsible for providing us with copies of report cards, which include teacher comments and an explanation of the grading symbols if other than A, B, C.

1. Submit your child's final report card for the 2010- 2011 school year by **December 15.**
2. Submit the first quarter/trimester report card for this current school year by **December 15.**
3. Submit the first semester report card by **February 10th.**

Recommendation Forms:

Please carefully read the instructions on every form.

1. Arrange for us to receive two **TEACHER REFERENCE REPORTS** from your child's current teachers.
2. The **MENTOR REFERENCE REPORTS** are recommended but not required. It is appropriate to ask coaches, extra-curricular instructors, or mentors to fill these out.

School Records:

Depending upon the school your child now attends, specific records must be provided. Again, it is the parent's responsibility to provide these records.

1. If your child currently attends a **public elementary school in the State of Hawaii**, please submit a copy of his/her most recent standardized test score report. No official transcript is required.
2. If your child now attends an **independent (private) school**, public intermediate or high school in Hawaii, or any school outside the State of Hawaii, please complete and sign the **CONSENT FOR RELEASE OF INFORMATION** on the reverse side of the **REFERENCE REPORT FOR ADMINISTRATOR** and give it to the principal or counselor at the current school.

** Please note: 'Iolani School reserves the right to require additional documentation for students with learning disabilities.*

Admission Testing:

Applicants to grades 6-11 take the **SECONDARY SCHOOL ADMISSION TEST (SSAT)** and arrange to have the scores sent directly to us.

1. Applicants must take the SSAT on **October 15, November 12, December 10, or January 7.**
2. You may register online at www.ssat.org.

Applicants to grade twelve submit copies of their scores on the **PSAT, SAT** and/or **ACT** college entrance examinations. They do not take the SSAT.

Activity Session/Interview:

All sixth grade applicants attend an activity session on campus. Candidates for grades 7-12 come to 'Iolani for a personal interview. Parents receive notice by mail at least two weeks prior to the scheduled appointment, and both parents are encouraged to accompany their child to the activity session/interview.

Decision letters are mailed by March 30.
