



Grades 6-12 Admission Procedure and Checklist

Overview

'Iolani admits 50 children per grade in grades 6, 7 and 9. Eighth grade admission varies depending on space available, but ranges from 15-20 students.

Next Steps

- Create an account on Ravenna at www.ravenna-hub.com. Keep your login and password handy as they are your gateway to the entire application process. All admission communication will be sent to the primary account user's email address. If you are a two parent household, please list both parents when setting up your account. Single parent households should note any additional parent by listing them in a second household, as appropriate.
- Complete the online application through Ravenna and submit application fee (\$125) by December 1, 2019.
- Activity Session (Gr. 6) or Interview (Grs. 7-12)
Schedules will be emailed prior to the Saturday appointment. Applicants will be asked to complete a writing sample on that day. Off island candidates may submit a personal statement in lieu of an interview.
- Register now to take any of the Secondary School Admissions Test (SSAT) at www.ssat.org in October, November, December, or January. 'Iolani School's code is 4144. Grade 12 candidates are exempt from taking the SSAT, but must submit a PSAT, SAT and/or ACT college exam score(s).
- By January 31, 2020, follow upload instructions on Ravenna to submit:
 - last year's final report card, including comments (2018-19)
 - this year's semester/trimester report card (2019-20)
 - copies of most recent standardized test scores if available
- Please wait until after November 30 to ask your child's *current* English, Math, History or Science teachers to complete a Teacher Reference Report. This allows the teacher more time to get to know your child. Then, follow instructions on Ravenna to delegate *two* Teacher Reference Reports (teacher email needed), due January 31, 2020.
- Follow instructions on Ravenna to delegate Mentor Reference Reports (recommended) and/or Administrator Report (optional). All are due by January 31, 2020.

For Grade 6 only: Complete the SSAT Character Skills Snapshot online at www.ssat.org by December 31, 2019, and send results to 'Iolani School (code 4144). Please note: Snapshot results takes 2-3 weeks to process.
