



Boarding FAQs

Admissions

What is the cost of 'Iolani School's boarding program?

Boarding student tuition and fees can be found [here](#). Additional costs such as our technology fee, travel expenses, health insurance, books and school supplies are not included.

Can a student from Oahu apply for boarding admission?

Students from Oahu may apply for our boarding program. Geographic preference may be given based on the need to board.

Is there a separate application for international students?

No, all boarding applicants must create and submit an application through Ravenna at www.ravenna-hub.com or use your SSAT account at ssat.org/sao and apply using the SAO (Standard Application Online). Boarding applications will be accepted from August 1, 2021 to January 15, 2022. Late applications will be accepted based upon availability in the boarding program. Please contact boarding@iolani.org if you would like to apply after our deadline has passed.

What testing does 'Iolani School require for a boarding applicant?

- All applicants are required to submit a Secondary School Admission Test (SSAT) score. Please make sure test scores are sent directly to 'Iolani School. Our school code is **4144**.
- Applicants whose first language is not English, must take an English Proficiency Test. We accept the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL ibt), the International English Language Testing System (IELTS), or the Duolingo English Test. Our TOEFL code is **B845**.

What is the requirement for test scores?

There is no minimum requirement for test scores.

Does 'Iolani School offer English as a Second Language (ESL) courses?

No, we do not offer an ESL program as part of our curriculum.

Does 'Iolani enroll new seniors (12th graders)?

No, we do not enroll students entering 12th grade. Students entering 9th, 10th, and 11th grade may apply.

Are interviews required?

Yes, an interview is a required part of the application process. Interviews may take place in-person or online. Interviews must be completed by January 31, 2022. Please schedule your interview after your application has been submitted. To schedule, please email boarding@iolani.org

Is financial aid available for international students?

No, we typically do not award financial aid to international students.

How are admissions decisions made?

There is no formula to our admission decisions. Each application is important to us and all pieces of the application are taken into account when determining an admission decision. All applications are reviewed by multiple members of our admission committee, which is made up of various faculty and staff across campus.

When and how does 'Iolani School communicate admission decisions?

All admission decisions are emailed on March 10.

Residential Life:**Does 'Iolani School require students to wear uniforms?**

'Iolani School does not require students to wear uniforms. All students must abide by our dress code.

Are students allowed to remain on campus over school breaks?

The residential hall closes for Thanksgiving, Christmas and Spring breaks and students are required to leave campus. Our residential team will assist students with home stay options for Thanksgiving break, should they need support.

How many students does one House Parent support?

Each floor of our dormitory will have one House Parent on duty at all times. Each floor has the capacity for 28 students. Within each floor "house" there is a team of faculty/staff members who serve as the House Parent for that floor. Advisory groups are as small as 4-6 students.

Is there security at 'Iolani School?

'Iolani School is an enclosed/gated urban school with an open campus; security guards are posted at various campus entry points and throughout campus 24-hours a day. When students are in the dormitory, there are also House Parents or a Head of House on duty.

How often does the Advisor communicate with parents via email?

Advisors will communicate with parents regularly throughout the school year. Additionally, they are always available to serve as a resource in connecting parents to other departments on campus to help answer any questions that may arise. The advisor serves as the primary contact for boarding students. Families will also receive updates from their child's Head of House and the Residential Life Office throughout the year.

Are there any parent-teacher conferences throughout the semester?

We do not necessarily offer teacher to parent conferences, however, parent to House Parent communication will happen at the end of each quarter, and more frequently if necessary.
