Entering Grades K-6

Program Information

The Lower School Summer Programs offer a diverse range of enrichment and academic reinforcement courses to students entering grades (EG) Kindergarten to 6 on the 'lolani School campus. A variety of class durations are offered and include three-week and six-week courses. Courses are designed to meet students' needs not only in preparation for the regular school year, but also in subjects of interest and opportunities for exploration, self-expression and creativity.

'Iolani Summer Programs welcomes 'Iolani and visiting students to experience the ONE TEAM ethos that shapes and defines our programs which foster educational excellence and personal growth in an environment that values collaboration, humility, and respect for all community members.

Before registering for classes, we kindly ask that you carefully read through the Summer Catalogue and Handbook with your child to learn more about our programs and their requirements.

Courses with limited enrollment eligibility are noted in the course description. You may enroll in either Session 1 OR Session 2 classes, not both as curriculum will repeat, unless otherwise noted in the course description.

Program Eligibility

- » Lower School Summer Programs are open to current 'lolani students who attended for the entirety of the 2023-2024 school year, accepted and enrolling 'lolani admissions students for the 2024-2025 school year, siblings of current 'lolani students, and visiting students
- » Eligible students should enroll in courses for the grade level they will enter in the fall 2024-2025 school year
- » Courses with limited enrollment eligibility are noted in the course description
- » Current 'Iolani students will have priority for course enrollments
- » Kindergarten courses are open to newly admitted and enrolling 'lolani students ONLY
- » Students attending school during the regular school year in the state of Hawai'i and US mainland must turn 6 (six) years old before June 10, 2024 to register.
- » Students attending school during the regular school year outside the United States must turn 7 (seven) years old before June 10, 2024, and must complete additional forms to register. Please see the Requirements for International Students section of the Handbook.
- » Students who have been dismissed from 'lolani for disciplinary reasons may not enroll in Summer Programs unless they have been readmitted to 'lolani School and have approval by their Dean
- » Review additional requirements listed in the handbook

Before registering, please carefully read through the "Registration FAQ" page and other important information found in the Summer Programs Handbook at summer.iolani.org.

How to Register

Registration for 'Iolani Summer Programs must be completed online via the Summer Programs Registration Portal found on the website (summer.iolani.org). No formal application is required for Summer Programs; simply register online on your assigned date and time for eligible courses.

Registrations will not be accepted by walk-in, email, telephone or fax. Registrations received prior to your child's assigned date and time, as well as incomplete registrations, will not be accepted. Registration fills quickly and program spaces are limited, so we recommend registering at the opening time.

Course Selection

Please register your child for the grade level they will be **entering** in the

Courses with limited enrollment eligibility are noted in the course description. Current 'lolani students will have priority for all course enrollments. You may enroll in either Session 1 OR Session 2 classes, not both, as curriculum will repeat, unless otherwise noted in the course description.

Lower School Summer Programs operate similar to a regular school day. Students must have a full morning schedule with classes from 7:30 am - 11:40 am, and must be picked up immediately after class ends, unless they have afternoon classes scheduled.

Lower School students may not register for afternoon classes only, they must have a full morning schedule in order to take afternoon classes.

As you prepare your child's summer class schedule, it is recommended that you carefully determine a list of preferred classes, along with 1-2 alternate classes in the event the first choice class is unavailable at the time of registration.

Please use the "Course Planning Worksheet" as a tool to map out your child's class schedule and preferences.

Waitlists

Maximum class sizes range from 12 to 24 students, and courses tend to fill quickly during registration. If your child is signed up on the waitlist, there is no guarantee of placement in the course. Waitlists are processed as space becomes available. The Summer Programs Office will notify the parent/guardian via email if the student clears the waitlist or if unable to accommodate the waitlist request up to the start date of the program. Classes with exceptionally long waitlists will no longer be accessible on the Registration Portal. Please read the Handbook for additional details.

Tuition and Fees

The tuition payment in full is due at the time of online registration. You may pay by Visa, Mastercard, or American Express during online registration. Class prices are listed with the courses. Registration is not complete until paid for and submitted through the Registration Portal. Upon submission, you will receive a confirmation email.

Withdrawal and Refund Policy

Students or parents who initiate course withdrawals after submitting their registration will be subject to a refund based on the date when the Summer Programs Office receives written notification from parents for the student's withdrawal. Any changes should be submitted via email to LSsummer@iolani.org (gr. K-6). Once the registration has been processed, the maximum amount of refund will be 50% of each course.

The following schedule determines the amount of the refund:

- 50% refund through Thursday, May 9
- No refunds starting Friday, May 10

There are no refunds or prorated billing for course time missed. The course fee applies regardless of how many days a child participates in the program. There will be no refunds for unused days.

Course Additions and Changes

Any requested changes, including adding classes or Meal Plan, should be submitted via email to LSsummer@iolani.org (gr. K-6). Please DO NOT go back into the Registration Portal to add classes as this may affect the initial selection of classes. Change requests are subject to approval.

Students or parents who initiate course changes (replacing one course for another, requesting time changes) after submitting their registration will be charged \$50.00 for each change requested. Course changes after the course begins will incur a \$100.00 charge. No course changes permitted after the first two meetings of the course.

Courses cannot be dropped or changed online. Please email LSsummer@iolani.org (gr. K-6) with your child's full name, grade and details of your change request.

Canceled Courses

Courses may be canceled due to insufficient enrollment or at the discretion of the Summer Programs Office. If this occurs, parents will be notified via email and we will assist you in finding an alternative course for your child, if space is available.

Late Registration

Online registration will close on Friday, May 10 for all courses and programs. Please contact LSsummer@iolani.org with the student's name, grade level, and desired course if you would like to register after May 10. Online registration will not be available after that date.

If there is space in the desired course after the registration close date, a \$100.00 late fee per course will be assessed prior to course placement.

Meal Plan will not be available for purchase after Friday, May 10.

Kick Start Kindergarten

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:25 am \$1.010

*Open to newly enrolling 'Iolani Kindergarten students for the 2024 - 2025 School Year ONLY

This class will uncover some of the wonder involved in the day-to-day life of Kindergarten at 'Iolani School. Students will explore and begin to understand classroom expectations via art, music, math, writing, and reading. Since Kindergarten is the entry point to a formal education, students will begin to understand the etiquette required for a successful learning experience as an 'Iolani Raider. Students will develop meaningful work habits through persistence and will practice readiness by applying past knowledge to new situations. Your child will participate in a classroom that supports creating, imagining, and innovating. Kindergarten, here I come!

Entering Grade 1

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:40 am \$1,010

Entering Grade 1 offers incoming first graders a chance to build upon the fundamentals developed during the school year to ensure a smooth transition into the next grade level. The primary goal of this course is to establish the solid foundation required for entering first grade using engaging content in an interactive format designed to help students develop a love of reading and a passion for math!

The morning is scheduled into separate instructional times focused on language arts and math. Rising grade 1 students will engage in activities to sharpen their language arts skills such as handwriting, sight word recognition, decoding words, and reading comprehension. The math curriculum emphasizes counting exploration, comparing numbers, recognizing number patterns and other concepts using manipulatives and hands on strategies to make learning math fun. Opportunities to work with Common Core Strategies are incorporated throughout the duration of this class.

Keiki O Ka Lā Kindergarten-Grade 1

Session 1 (June 10 - June 28) 7:30 am - 11:40 am Session 2 (July 1 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:40 am \$575

Students may enroll in BOTH sessions.

Keiki o Ka La - the Sunshine Kids! We are the Sunshine Kids! Our program incorporates daily opportunities which focus on working as One Team, while exploring a variety of topics and themes. Lessons will intertwine science experiments, arts and crafts projects, music, geography, math, and language arts. We will explore our 'lolani campus as we participate in outdoor adventures such as hugging trees, cloud watching, bug hunting, and bird walks. Children will enjoy learning more about our special island home as we share legends, knowledge of plants, animals, and Hawaiian games. Daily discussions will focus on brainteasers and problem solving strategies that continue to enable our keiki to build a healthy mind and body. We are Keiki O Ka Lā! Watch us shine!

Discover Hawai'i Grade 1

Session 1 (June 10 - June 28) 7:30 am - 11:40 am Session 2 (July 1 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:40 am \$595

E komo mai! Welcome to Discover Hawai'i, a course that combines Hawaiian culture and history with reading, writing, and science. Learn about each of the eight major islands and their unique features. The students will gain an appreciation of the land and how they can mālama (take care) of it for our future. Join us as we embark on a three-week journey to discover what makes our island home so special.

Happy Hands, Happy Hearts Grade 1

Session 1 (June 10 - June 28) 7:30 am - 11:40 am Session 2 (July 1 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:40 am

Welcome to a fun summer exploration that nurtures young hands and hearts. Learners will embark on a journey of discovery through hands-on crafts like threading beads, cutting and pasting, that will refine their fine motor skills, including hand-eye coordination and finger dexterity. Students will also participate in interactive games and engaging activities to promote wellness and mindfulness, encourage positive social interactions and collaboration, and develop their problem-solving skills.

Power Up with STEAM Grade 1

Session 1 (June 10 - June 28) 7:30 am - 11:40 am Session 2 (July 1 - July 19) 7:30 am - 11:40 am \$575

Young builders will harness the power of STEAM (science, technology, engineering, art, math) to address both real-life challenges and those from storybooks. Employing the engineering and design process, students will construct a new bridge for the Billy Goats Gruff and devise creative solutions for challenges within the K-1 Community. Additionally, students will gain proficiency in utilizing green screen technology and engage in scientific experiments, math problem-solving, and imaginative art projects to further power up their skills.

Entering Grade 2 - Language Arts

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 9:25 am OR 9:45 am - 11:40 am \$575

Entering Grade 2 Language Arts offers incoming second graders a chance to build upon the fundamentals developed during the school year to ensure a smooth transition into the next grade level. The primary goal of this course is to establish the solid foundation required for entering second grade using engaging content in an interactive format design to help students develop a love for reading and writing.

Our language arts goal is for summer students to develop a love of reading and writing that is strong enough to keep pencils and journals in their hands all through the summer months and straight into second grade! Reading and writing are reciprocal processes, therefore instruction is taught together.

Entering Grade 2 - Math

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 9:25 am OR 9:45 am - 11:40 am \$575

Entering Grade 2 Math offers incoming second graders a chance to build upon the fundamentals developed during the school year to ensure a smooth transition into the next grade level. The primary goal of this course is to establish the solid foundation required for entering second grade using engaging content in an interactive format design to help students develop a passion for math.

The math curriculum emphasizes data interpretation, measuring concepts, as well as identifying, composing, and partitioning shapes. As math detectives, students will investigate and implement new strategies that they learn. Opportunities to work with Common Core Strategies are incorporated throughout the duration of this class.

Entering Grade 3 - Language Arts

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 9:25 am OR 9:45 am - 11:40 am \$575

Entering Grade 3 Language Arts offers incoming third graders a chance to build upon the fundamentals developed during the school year to ensure a smooth transition into the next grade level. The primary goal of this course is to establish the solid foundation required for entering third grade using engaging content in an interactive format designed to help students develop a love for reading and writing.

Language Arts units will engage students through a range of sources drawing from fiction, non-fiction, fairy tales and fantasy building foundational reading skills. Engaging with a variety of texts, students will strengthen their reading comprehension and inference skills. Students will cycle through the writing process and become more independent writers learning to apply their creative voice to their work.

Entering Grade 3 - Math

6 weeks (June 10 - July 19) 7:30 am - 9:25 am OR 9:45 am - 11:40 am

Entering Grade 3 Math offers incoming third graders a chance to build upon the fundamentals developed during the school year to ensure a smooth transition into the next grade level. The primary goal of this course is to establish the solid foundation required for entering third grade using engaging content in an interactive format designed to help students develop a passion for math.

Incoming third graders will learn the importance of place value and how it connects to all areas of mathematics. Basic rounding will be reinforced, along with foundational computation skills for addition and subtraction. They will explore various problem solving strategies, discovering there are a myriad of ways to arrive at a reasonable solution to solve the mystery of the word puzzle. Opportunities to work with Singapore Math and Common Core Strategies are incorporated throughout the duration of this class.

Breaks R4 Kidz Grade 2-3

Session 1 (June 10 - June 28) 9:45 am - 11:40 am Session 2 (July 1 - July 19) 9:45 am - 11:40 am

Students may enroll in BOTH sessions. Families all around the world are learning about the newest event being added to the 2024 Paris Olympic Games - a fun nostalgic blast from the past we know as Break Dance or (Breakin). Breaks R4 Kidz is a culturally immersive program that paints a picture of the origins of Hiphop culture coming from Bronx NY to Hawaii through the Art of Breakin. At the end of the session your child will be thoroughly educated in the four core elements of Hiphop which are Breakin, Dj, Rap, and Urban Art.
