## Message About Online Purchasing of Textbooks for 2018-19 School Year

Dear 'Iolani Upper School Parents,

'Iolani School is continuing its partnership with MBS Direct ([www.mbsDirect.net](http://www.mbsDirect.net)) to offer families the convenience of online purchasing of school books for the 2018-19 school year.

To make online ordering for this upcoming fall semester as easy as possible, we have outlined some important points below:

- Starting July 11th, you may begin ordering textbooks for the first semester of the 2018-19 school year. Order books for ONLY the first semester and yearlong classes. Second semester books will be available for purchase in December 2018.
- To order textbooks, go to the MBS Direct website <http://bookstore.mbsdirect.net/iolani.htm> . Then select "Let's Get Started" and follow the prompts. Order from July 16 - July 29, 2018 to get FREE SHIPPING on orders of \$99 or more excluding marketplace vendors. \*Offer expires at 11:59 p.m. HST on July 29.
- The master list by class for all required books for Grades 7 - 12 is posted on the school website at <https://www.iolani.org/about/business-office/campus-store>
- If a class requires digital or e-books, please do not download these materials until after August 15. Most digital books have an expiration date and we want to ensure the subscription timeframe for these materials coincides with the entire semester and/or school year. Students should download digital materials directly to their 'Iolani-issued iPads.
- Items (not available through MBS Direct such as Japanese packets, visor gogs and other materials) that need to be purchased at the 'Iolani campus store in the Nangaku Building will be available from August 1st between 7 a.m. - 3:30 pm, Monday - Friday.
